ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

JUN 18 2008

I

The name of this corporation is Notre Dame Institute (NDI) Alumni Endowment Foundation, Inc.

II

A. This corporation is a nonprofit PUBLIC BENEFIT CORPORATION and is not organized for the private gain of any person. It is organized under the Nonprofit Public Benefit Corporation Law for public and charitable purposes.

B. The specific purpose of this corporation is to support scholars, faculty development, physical facilities improvement, library and laboratory services, and manage the financial resources for the benefit of NDI at Aringay, La Union, Philippines, to solicit monetary contributions and undertake fund raising activities. To provide funding and monitoring of projects that are approved by the Board of Trustees with the recommendations of the donor/s for specific purposes that meet the needs of NDI. To bring together all alumni of NDI for a meeting at least once every 3 years at a place and time to be determined by the Board of Trustees to review the operation of the foundation and to determine possible improvements of NDI.


A. This corporation is organized and operated exclusively for charitable purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

B. No substantial part of the activities of this corporation shall consist of carrying on propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate or intervene in any political campaign (including the publishing or distribution of statements) on behalf of any candidate for public office.

The property of this corporation is irrevocably dedicated to charitable purposes and no part of the net income or assets of this corporation shall ever inure to the benefit of any director, officer, or member thereof or to the benefit of any private person. Upon the dissolution or winding up of the corporation, its assets remaining after payment, or provision for payment, of all debts and liabilities of this corporation shall be distributed to a nonprofit fund, foundation, or corporation which is organized and operated exclusively for charitable purposes and which has established its tax exempt status under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.
